- Medical Surveillance Case Management
- Return-to-work and fitness-for-duty evaluations

The Boston University Research Occupational Health Program services are in compliance with OSHA, CDC, and other regulatory requirements. The following information should be useful to researchers in assessing individual risk and avoiding potential health problems, particularly those associated with exposure to laboratory animals.

Questions?

Is this a mandatory requirement to contact ROHP if I am a Researcher?

Answer: Since February 2010 BU has set this new mandate for all Researchers to contact ROHP to have all staff medically cleared.

When should I contact ROHP?

Answer: As soon as you have a new or renewed research protocol .

What do I need to be medically cleared?

Answer: That depends on the kind of research you are doing. Please visit our website at WWW.ROHP@BU.EDU where you will find all the forms to fill out and submit to ROHP. You will be contacted by ROHP once these forms are submitted. This is the first step in attaining your medical clearance.
